Guided Tour to Santa María del Mar, one of the only perfectly-finished Catalan Gothic churches. Its outer walls display, the great height of the nave and its octagonal columns are the main features which make Santa María so special.

The visit will be followed by a tour to The Círculo del Liceo inaugurated in 1847. Its main attraction is undoubtedly the collection of paintings and sculptures as well as its magnificent library. At the Liceo we will enjoy a glass of cava enlivened by a string quartet.
